Faith in the City, the association of downtown churches and synagogue, will sponsor a special interfaith community service in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., on Friday, Jan. 15, 2010, at 7:30 p.m. The service will be held at historic Temple Israel, 137 NE 19th Street. The speaker for the evening will be Dr. Marvin Dunn, retired professor of psychology at Florida International University. Please join us as we celebrate the diversity of our faith community...or if you are unable to, the program will be broadcast on 880 AM, and streamed live over the internet.

Choral Evensong on January 24 will be a festive event in the life of our Diocese. The Bishop has nominated and the Cathedral Chapter has appointed six individuals from throughout Southeast Florida whose ministries have contributed to the life of the Cathedral and the Diocese to serve as Honorary Canons of Trinity. Be sure to join us for this wonderful evening of song and celebration.

Just-in-Time Ministry: Trinity's Outreach Committee is starting a new "list serve" ministry to help struggling families with last-minute quality of life needs. Please join us in this endeavor! All you need to do is send your email address to Maria Mena (mmena02@gmail.com) to join the list serve. Then, as needs come through the list serve, you'll be able to "reply to all" to claim sponsorship of a given expense for a family or child. Your sponsorship will involve reimbursing clergy discretionary accounts through which needs will be initially met. All candidates for this aid will be pre-screened to ascertain neediness.

Fr. James Reho will be spending a month as a guest of the Church of South India with Dr. Randall Giles, a missionary of the Episcopal Church who, among other projects, works with poor Dalit ("untouchable") villagers in Tamil Nadu to help them adapt their indigenous music to liturgical worship and to form empowering spiritual communities through sacred music and art. Fr. Reho will visit a number of these villages to learn how

community life can be strengthened through grass roots liturgical experience, and will also serve as a liaison to Dr. Giles with Syrian Orthodox communities in the province of Kerala. The Syrian Orthodox Church is one of the oldest churches of Christendom, tracing its lineage back to St. Thomas the Apostle and using Aramaic (Jesus' "mother tongue") in its services. Further, Fr. Reho will take part in conversations around the use of indigenous music, chant, and kirtan in Anglican worship with faculty members of the Anglican seminary in Madurai, as well as further his own study of yoga and Indian percussion through study at the Diocesan School of Liturgy and Music in Chennai and a visit to several Christian ashrams. This experience has been made possible by the Seminary Commission on Mission of the Episcopal Church, which awarded James a grant to travel to South India to study and work with Dr. Giles. On February 28th Fr. Reho will present a summary of his experiences through video, picture, and story at the Adult Forum. You can follow Fr.
